We wear the paper poppy as a symbol of Remembrance, to remember the fallen service men and women killed in conflict.



This year, Armistice Day, Remembrance Day will fall on the 100th anniversary of the end of the First World War.

A two minute silence is held to mark the occasion - on the eleventh hour of the eleventh day of the eleventh month - to remember those killed in the two World Wars and the 12,000 British servicemen killed or injured since 1945. The Armistice essentially ended four years of fighting in the World War I.
