Food allergies are very difficult to understand if you do not live with them, we have a responsibility within school to ensure that children in our care stay safe. Allergic reactions can be triggered by touching surfaces such as a computer keyboards, books or a table top if these things have previously been used by someone who had eaten nut products.
